- ▶ Application process opens: Mid-February 2017
- Application deadline: May 12, 2017
- ➤ Students: 20 students, ages 11-15, for entering grades 6,7,8 (other grades by permission of Francis Parker and IEM)
- Requirement: Min. TOEFL score of 50, or interview required

PROGRAM COST:

- Application Fee: \$100 (non-refundable)
- Porgram Fee:
 - \$5,200 (pay in full by April 1)
 - \$5,500 (pay in full by May 12)
 - \$6,000 (after May 12)

PROGRAM PACKAGE INCLUDES:

- ▶ Pick-up/drop-off at San Diego International Airport
- ► Homestay accommodations. A host family may host 2-4 international students at a time. Each student has his/her own bed. No more than two students per room.
- ▶ Breakfast and dinner prepared by the host family, lunch provided by Parker (Monday Friday). Weekend meals provided by the host family.
- ▶ Transportation to and from extracurricular activities by Parker bus.
- Paid admission fees for extracurricular activities.
- ▶ A local 24-hour emergency telephone emergency service.

FEES NOT INCLUDED:

- Any service fees and/or charges to secure travel (tourist) visa
- Airfare
- Unaccompanied travel fee for minors
- Supplemental travel and health insurance
- > Additional meals not provided by the host family or Parker

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Student must provide a valid passport, visa, statement of health condition and a completed application.
- 2) Student must provide valid travel insurance that covers the student's time in the U.S. while attending program.
- 3) The student must abide by all Parker or homestay rules. The student cannot leave the School or homestay without approval from the Program Director and a parent.
- 4) A \$250 homestay deposit is not included in the program fee. This fee needs to be paid in cash upon arrival. Upon the student's departure, if no damages, the deposit will be refunded to the student or family as appropriate.
- 5) No refund will be made if the student is expelled from the program due to a violation of Parker or general program rules.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Should an applicant elect to cancel enrollment in the 2017 Parker Summer Program, the following refund schedule applies:

Through June 15: 80% refund, except for \$100

application fee

Through June 26: 50% refund, except for \$100

application fee

After June 26: No refunds issued, barring

extraordinary circumstances.
