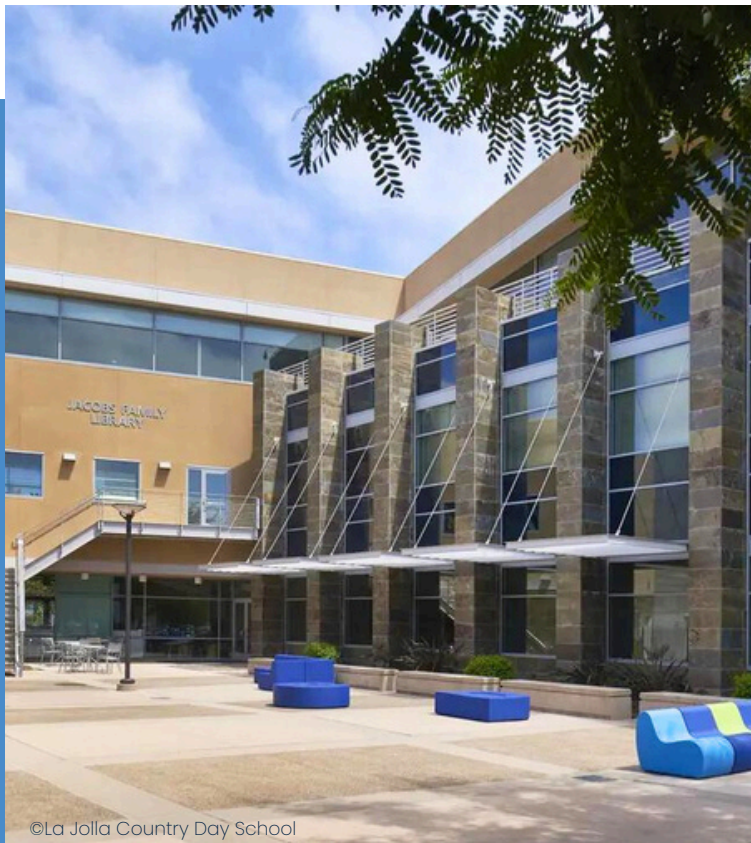
REQUIREMENTS
